- HAND SANITIZER & THERMOMETER:** To help ensure a safe start to your week of Family Camp, all families are expected to take temps prior to arrival. If anyone in your party has a temperature or feels unwell, it would be prudent for them to stay home. Temperature checks and symptom monitoring is still encouraged by all on grounds guests along with frequent hand washing & use of hand sanitizer.
- MEALS:** The GLM dining room is open for lunch and dinner. Please bring (or purchase near us) your breakfast foods for the week. Full kitchen access is available in all accommodations. For those in a Lodge with a shared kitchen, a private mini fridge can be rented for \$40 a week. Call our office soon as availability is limited. Meals will feature our signature self-serve buffets and each person going through the buffet will receive hand sanitizer before entering the line to enjoy the mouthwatering entrées and delicious desserts created by our amazing culinary team.
- COFFEE, FILTERS, CREAM, SUGAR, SEASONINGS:** We are asking guests to bring these items for their week and take them home at departure. This reduces any chance of contamination and helps keep our facility running smoothly from week to week.

GLOSSARY OF GLM TERMS

BBBSB "BROWN BAG BIBLE STUDY BONANZA": A fun and spiritually enriching creative devotional for the entire family.

COVE KIDS & YOUTH PROFILE: A form is required for all children attending GLM programming. The profile assists your child's counselor to better understand your child's personality, spiritual perspective, and emotional needs.

CAMP NAME: Our summer staffers, as well as our permanent staff, have all been given a Camp Name that they go by throughout the summer. Make sure to ask some of the staffers to tell you how they got their Camp Name. You'll hear some great stories!

CASHLESS ACCOUNT: A cash-free charge account, set up at Saturday check-in, that provides spending power at our Sweet-n-Counter, Dock Shop, Creation Station, Front Desk, and Lil' Pop Shop, near the beach, without having to carry cash.

COVE KIDS: Our program for little ones, ages newborn to entering kindergarten. Cove Kids has a creative curriculum and fun activities led by an all-female, college-age staff.

DOCK SHOP: Located in the Ministry Center, the Dock Shop is our retail store, featuring Gull Lake Ministries' shirts, sweatshirts, hats, blankets, stuffed animals, toys, books, and many other great gifts. The Dock Shop is open when the Ministry Center is open.

EN GEDI: A time at the end of the evening for guests and staff to praise Jesus and delight in Him. Summer staff is officially off duty during this time so they can recharge with God and prepare their hearts and minds for another full day of service. Guests who are old enough to appreciate the reverence during this time are welcome to join in.

FAM BAM: Family free-time in the Ministry Center. The full gym, game room, climbing wall, Sweet-n-Counter, Dock Shop, pickleball courts, octaball, and bowling alley are all open and ready for family fun!

FAMILY HUDDLE: A pre-game, high-energy family warm-up starting at 9:30 a.m. in the Tabernacle.

HAC: Short for High Adventure Course. With a height of 40 feet, our ropes course has 24 different elements spread over three increasingly difficult heights.

HIGH TIDE: Our fun-filled program for pre-teens and teens, 7th through 12th grades, that meets every day for Bible studies and interactive activities with their energetic counselors.

LAKESIDE: Our program for children entering grades 1st through 6th, that supercharges kids with God's love and truth in a fun and challenging environment.

LIL' POP SHOP: Located near the beach at the Dining Room, the Lil' Pop Shop offers ice cream, pop, snacks, and candy. You may use your cashless account for convenient purchasing, and concessions are available during afternoon free-time.

MINISTRY CENTER "MC": The Ministry Center features two large lobbies with fireplaces, the Sweet-n-Counter snack shop, the Dock Shop store, a game room, a craft room, a full gym with basketball, octaball, an indoor climbing wall, pickleball courts, a four-lane bowling alley, and fitness equipment with walking track (must be 18 or older to access fitness area). The front desk is also available for any questions you might have during your stay and summer registration can be done here or online.

POP 3: A late evening, family free-time in the dining room with a variety of board and table games to play with camp staff, with your "pop", eating popcorn, drinking soda pop, and maybe winning a free ring pop when popping the trouble board on entering.

QUADZILLA: Our 40-foot outdoor tower that features three zip lines, a climbing wall, two leaps of faith, and a giant screamer swing.

SWEET-N-COUNTER: The Sweet-n-Counter is located in the main lobby of the Ministry Center providing ice cream, shakes, pop, snacks, and candy. The Sweet-n-Counter is open during the afternoon free-time and for at least an hour following the evening program for Fam Bam (an optional, late evening game and fellowship time, in our 52,000 square foot Ministry Center, with the summer staff and guests). Don't forget to use your cashless account for convenience!

TABERNACLE "TAB": A 750-person theater-style meeting space, built in 1904. Worship, speaker sessions, family huddle, and the talent show are held at the Tabernacle.
